## Highlights



**适耕庄**

这是雪兰莪的“饭碗”——一片用大地记录时光的地方。春天，稻田翻滚如绿色海洋；收割时，它们化作金色拼布，沉甸甸地挂满谷粒。

在适耕庄，时间慢了下来。住进一间俯瞰稻田的民宿，走进稻米展览馆，了解每一粒米如何从田野走向餐桌；黄昏时分，前往热浪沙滩。看渔船静泊锚中，在古老的许愿树上系上祈福彩带，让落日将天空染成琥珀与玫瑰交织的色彩。

这里没有宏大的景点，只有朴实本真的滋味——鲜虾和螃蟹蒸得恰到好处，路边摊的椰子水清甜解渴，还有当地人温暖而从容的笑脸。适耕庄不只是一个值得造访的景点，还是一个活生生的、呼吸着的社区，欢迎你走进它的故事。



**Sekinchan**

This is Selangor's "Rice Bowl" – a place where the land tells time. In spring, the fields roll like a green ocean; at harvest, they turn into a golden patchwork quilt, heavy with grain.

In Sekinchan, time slows down. Wake up in a homestay overlooking the paddy, step out to the Paddy Gallery to learn how each grain travels from field to plate, and as dusk falls, make your way to Redang Beach. Watch the fishing boats bob at anchor, tie a prayer ribbon to the ancient Wish Tree, and let the sunset paint the sky in shades of amber and rose.

This isn't a place of grand attractions. It's a place of honest flavours – fresh prawns and crabs steamed to perfection, coconut water from a roadside stall, and the warm, unhurried smiles of the locals. Sekinchan isn't just a destination to visit; it's a living, breathing community that welcomes you into its story.



### 沙克蒂印度庙

这是位于雪兰莪的一座宏伟印度教寺庙，散发着神秘的气息，精美的雕刻与秀丽的景观令人过目难忘。寺庙在白天和夜晚呈现出截然不同的风貌。白天，阳光倾泻而入，尽显其恢宏庄严之姿；夜晚，柔和的灯光将它化作一片宁静安详的美景。步入其中，你会感受到一种油然而生的平和与宁静——一次真正抚慰心灵的体验。



### Sri Shakti Temple

This magnificent Hindu temple in Kuala Lumpur/Selangor exudes an air of mystery, with impressive carvings and beautiful landscapes that leave a lasting impression. The temple takes on a completely different character between day and night. By day, sunlight streams through, revealing its grand and majestic presence. By night, gentle lighting transforms it into a vision of serene, tranquil beauty. Stepping inside, you'll feel an overwhelming sense of peace and calm—a truly comforting experience.



### 蓝眼泪

“Blue Tears” is a breathtaking natural phenomenon where the sea lights up with a magical electric-blue glow at night. This spectacle is caused by bioluminescent marine plankton, which emit a flash of blue light when disturbed by waves or movement. In Malaysia, it's one of the most sought-after natural wonders, often described as looking like thousands of tiny stars scattered across the dark water.



### Blue Tears

“蓝眼泪”是一种令人叹为观止的自然现象——夜晚的海面会闪烁着梦幻般的电蓝色光芒。这一奇观由发光的海洋浮游生物所致，当受到波浪或水流扰动时，它们会发出蓝色闪光。在马来西亚，这是最受追捧的自然奇观之一，常被形容为宛如成千上万颗细小的星星洒落在漆黑的海面上。



## 萤火虫

Thousands of fireflies blinking in perfect synchrony along a dark riverbank. The magic begins after sunset. Visitors board small, silent sampan boats and glide quietly along the Selangor River, surrounded by the mangrove trees that are home to these remarkable insects. The fireflies—belonging to the species *Pteroptyx tener*—perch on the leaves of Berembang trees and flash their green lights in unison, roughly three times per second. At their peak, they illuminate the trees like a spectacular, living Christmas display, with countless points of light reflecting on the still water. It is an experience that feels both serene and otherworldly.



## Firefly Tour

成千上万只萤火虫沿着黑暗的河岸同步闪烁，仿佛在共舞。这份奇妙的景象在日落之后拉开序幕。游客登上安静的小舢板，沿着雪兰莪河悄然滑行，四周是红树林，而这些非凡的小生灵便栖息其间。这些萤火虫属于翼萤属 (*Pteroptyx tener*)，它们停驻在柏伦邦树的叶片上，以大约每秒三次的频率同步发出绿色荧光。在高峰期，它们将树木点亮，犹如一株壮观而鲜活的活动圣诞树，无数光点倒映在静谧的水面上，如星辉洒落。这是一次既宁静又恍若置身异境的神奇体验。
